Cameron has 20 years experience in food and agriculture research, product development, international business, commercialisation and entrepreneurship.

Over the last 4 years while working at UniQuest, Cameron founded three food or agriculture start-up companies based on University of Queensland technologies. Each of these companies raised equity capital from Business Angels or Venture Capital organisations.

Cameron is now the Managing Director of one of these companies, Aussie Colours, and is CEO of another, Progel. Cameron has been successful at leveraging each of the investments into the three start-up companies with significant non-diluting public funding from research and development corporations, the Australian Research Council and Commercialisation Australia. This has helped the fledgling companies develop their platform technologies substantially further than would have been possible with investor capital alone.

Cameron is passionate about food and agriculture research commercialisation and entrepreneurship and of course, food and agriculture products themselves.
