Dr Graeme Woodrow, PhD, FTSE
Director, Health Technologies Strategy
CSIRO, Australia

Graeme Woodrow is Head of Strategy and Implementation for CSIRO's Preventative Health Flagship, and since 2007 he has been joint leader of the Health Initiative of the Global Research Alliance (GRA), an international alliance focused on the developing world.

He also leads a programme aimed at developing appropriate health diagnostic tools for people with infectious disease using mobile phones and inexpensive sensors. From 2005 to June 2010 he was Chief of CSIRO Molecular and Health Technologies and from 2002 to 2005 Chief of CSIRO Health Sciences and Nutrition.

Prior to joining CSIRO he had 20 years in industry, spanning the pharmaceutical, agricultural and diagnostics industries in start-up, medium-sized and multi-national companies in Australia and Europe.

His early academic career involved research positions at Cambridge University (UK), University of Basel (Switzerland) and Monash University (Australia).

He is a Fellow of the Australian Academy of Technological Sciences and Engineering, Director of Bio21 Cluster, a Council member of EMBL Australia and a Fellow of the Australian Institute of Company Directors.
