Dr Simon Green
Senior Vice President Global R&D Product Development
CSL Limited, Australia

Simon Green was recruited to CSL Limited in 1998, following an exciting period of conducting scientific research in leading biotechnology companies, Genentech and Chiron Corporation in the San Francisco Bay area. He graduated as a biochemist from Monash University and completed his PhD in the field of immunology at Melbourne University.

During his time at CSL, Simon has led a number of R&D functions, developing a broad range of experience in both biotechnology and plasma products. Simon led a collaborative project with the Ludwig Institute for Cancer Research developing a melanoma vaccine. Simon crossed the border between recombinant and plasma proteins in 2004, heading up R&D for CLB Behring based in Marburg, Germany.



In 2006, Simon was promoted to the General Manager of the Marburg Site, overseeing approximately 2000 staff and the manufacture of 24 biological products for global markets. Starting in January 2008, Simon returned to his home town, Melbourne, as Senior Vice President, R&D Product Development devoted to building CSL's recombinant protein manufacturing capabilities.
