Dr Terry Longhurst joined Meat & Livestock Australia since 2003, and has been in the role of Manager Strategic Science since 2008.

Prior to MLA he completed a PhD in plant molecular genetics in 1991. He has worked as a researcher in a range of animal biology fields with a focus on application of molecular genetics and genomics applied to various biological systems.

Within MLA he leads the investment in strategic science research with a focus on funding high quality research to address difficult on-farm issues. The broad objective is identifying intractable redmeat industry issues which can be addressed by RD&E and to build the knowledge base required to develop practical solutions for producers. There has been a focus on genomics in cattle, sheep and pastures and there is continued investment in these fields to deliver research outcomes into practical industry solutions. There is also a current focus on identification of new investment opportunities to address high priority industry issues.
